I. Appointment of Assistant Vice President - Security effective on June 1, 2026

Brigadier General Romulo D. Quemado II PN(M) (Ret.) is a highly decorated military leader with over 38 years of leadership experience in national security, maritime

defense, intelligence, crisis management, and strategic operations. A member of the Philippine Military Academy Class of 1992, he held key leadership positions in the Armed Forces of the Philippines, including Deputy Commander of the Western Mindanao Command, Commander of the 1st Marine Brigade, and Deputy Commander of the Western Command overseeing Palawan and West Philippine Sea operations.

Brig. Gen. Quemado is a recipient of the AFP Distinguished Conduct Star and multiple awards for gallantry, leadership, and distinguished service. He completed advanced studies in Strategy & Policy and Defence Studies at the University of New South Wales, Australia, and executive leadership programs at the Asian Institute of Management and the National Defense College of the Philippines.
